
BALLOT REFERENDUM QUESTION

"Shall the Fort Wayne Community Schools, Allen County, Indiana, issue bonds or enter into a lease to finance the 2016 FWCS School Building Basic Renewal/Restoration and Safety Project which includes restoration and renovation work at approximately 42 buildings and which is estimated to cost not more than \$129,950,557 and is estimated to increase the property tax rate for debt service by 30.149 per \$100 of assessed valuation?

ACTUAL: NET ZERO TAX RATE IMPACT DUE TO PAYOFF OF PREVIOUS DEBT



This \$130 million dollar referendum comes with a net-zero tax rate impact due to offsetting costs and efficiencies to insure all FWCS will have air conditioning as well as up-to-date security systems.

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
