TABB Facility Minimum Design Criteria

NEMIC / ITI - TAB Facility Design Concept
Minimum Requirements for an Authorized TABB Practical Testing Facility

Introduction

This design concept features a sample Testing, Adjusting, and Balancing (TAB) Facility to be used as a guide for facilities that either already have, or want to build, an Authorized TABB Performance Testing Facility. The laboratory mechanical system is designed to include all major components of a typical HVAC system.

Section 1 This section represents the minimum systems and components necessary to successfully conduct a TABB performance exam test at a facility.

Section 2 The intent of this section is to provide examples of additional training scenarios that go beyond the minimum requirements of section 1. All the examples listed shall meet the minimum requirements of section 1.

Building Description

The laboratory concept is based on a nominal 30' x 30' area. The mechanical





Case Study – Philadelphia Fire Life Safety




- Unanimously passed City Council in January 2019
- FLS inspections kept many contractors in business during COVID-19 shutdown
- Currently have over 35 contractors performing this work



Case Study – Nevada Fire Life Safety

- Passed AB 297
- State Fire Marshal asked us to enter into Nevada Administrative Code
 - FSD, SCS, Kitchen Ventilation
- Advancing Training Capabilities
- Las Vegas Fire Smoke Damper (FSD) and Smoke Control System (SCS) Training



Case Study – California CalSHAPE – Ventilation Verification

Program budget is now \$994 million

75% for the ventilation program and 25% for the plumbing program

- \$550 million has been requested.
- \$444 million is remaining.

Reported Hours:

- Survey of 4% of CAL SMACNA Contractors representing all regions of California
 - 135,787 Hours



Case Study – Connecticut SB 423 – Ventilation Verification



Ventilation Verification Periodic Inspection

- IAQ survey completed by 2024 and repeated every 5 Years thereafter
- All Public Schools required by 2026

Funding

- Currently as part of School
 Construction Bonding Program
 - Allocated in 2022 \$150 Million
 - Allocated in 2023 \$375 Million



Case Study – Oregon HB3031 & Grant Program - Ventilation Verification

Legislation Ventilation Verification Periodic Inspection

- Initial assessment and then every 5 Years
 Grant Writer (NWRC)
 - NWRC provided budget for grant writing
 - Access to Federal Funding

Results

- 57 School Districts willing to Sign PLAs
- 33 Schools Districts selected = estimated \$825 Million in HVAC Infrastructure repairs and replacements


